Native plants have evolved and adapted to local conditions over thousands of years. They are vigorous and hardy, able to survive in the winter cold and summer heat. Once established, they require no irrigation or fertilization. They are resistant to most pests and diseases. Native plants also provide food and shelter for birds, butterflies and other desirable wildlife. Many help to enrich the soil. Their root systems help rainfall percolate into the soil, reducing erosion and runoff.
